6) Pickleball

A) Going well. No issue with increased fee as it's still quite reasonable. Northfield, Leyden and Bernardston (school district) residents get a \$20 discount. Capped the signups to 50 people and we are already half way there!

A) This coming Monday is Finance Committee meeting with NRC to go over budget for FY 25.

11) CPC Update

A) BE reports that project applications are due in soon. LF asked for another official support for the PTO to attempt to put in a pavilion behind the elementary school (\*NES had already supported this a few years ago during the last attempt). A motion was made by BE to officially support the building of the pavilion for the CPC. Seconded by CD, vote all yea.

12) Outdoor Pickleball court

A) BE asked the committee if they would officially support an application to the CPC for outdoor Pickleball court(s) put in by the Community Bible Church on their property, with the knowledge that they could likely be used by the NRC. JR made the motion, seconded by CD, vote all yea.

Games are umpired, are typically on Mondays and Thursdays, and run May to Aug. \$650 for the season. Team doesn't need to be only Northfield residents. Need approx. 15-20 players per team.
