- PILOT (Payment In Lieu Of Taxes)
  - Per MacEwen's request at the last meeting, Walker had reached out to Police, Fire and EMS to get a report on responses/call outs to the campus. At this time only Police and EMS had provided information which the board reviewed. Walker will follow up with the Fire Chief to see if he can provide information for the next meeting.
  - The Board of Assessors (BOA) would like Llamas to attend next month's meeting to review information received from Police and EMS and figure out the next steps in the process.
