Mask Policy. Right now for the most part all is going well with many patrons following the recommendation to wear a mask. There is a sign on the Children's Room door requesting that everyone entering wear a mask. Because local children are back in school, the Board of Library Trustees would like to put in place a full mask mandate again for all ages of patrons entering our building.
