- Meisner will get a hold of Bernie Kubiak our interim town administrator to repost and ad in the paper.

## Discussion on the Future of the Commission and the Plant:

- Walker and Meisner think there are too many commissions in town. Combining this commission with another department might be worth exploring in the future.
- Enterprise fund would have to be abolished
- BIlling has to be monitored and the potential of needing to hire a part time secretary is necessary. There needs to a reorganization and a simplification of the billing process.
- Regionalization of the sewer commission is something worth exploring. Thomas Walker, our Sewer Commissioner and our Highway Superintendent would volunteer to take

responsibility and control of the sewer department If a consolidation effort were to happen.
