- Lots of Flow. Under 100,000 gallons a day.
- Effluent quality going out is good. Influent quality coming in is terrible.
- Hard to find out who owns what when it comes to Mt Hermon, St Thomas Aquinas, and Moody Center.
- Wickline will get a hold of the only applicant we have for the full time operator position.
- Meisner will get a hold of Bernie Kubiak our interim town administrator to repost and ad in the paper.

Discussion on the Future of the Commission and the Plant:

- Walker and Meisner think there are too many commissions in town. Combining this commission with another department might be worth exploring in the future.
- Enterprise fund would have to be abolished
- Billing has to be monitored and the potential of needing to hire a part time secretary is necessary. There needs to a reorganization and a simplification of the billing process.
- Regionalization of the sewer commission is something worth exploring. Thomas Walker, our Sewer Commissioner and our Highway Superintendent would volunteer to take

responsibility and control of the sewer department If a consolidation effort were to happen.
