Review and approval of Previous Minutes- A review and approval of the November 8th, 2019 minutes as amended was **MOTIONED** and approved by Alex Meisner and Tom Walker. Passes unanimously.

Green Mountain Pipeline Discussion- Ray Bahr, has come before the board with a proposal for some capital upgrades for the sewer plant's piping.

- Evaluation of sewer lines and address operation, infrastructure and maintenance issues. A lot of our system may be manhole issues. There is 44786 ft of pipe. Locating and line manhole with a special cement coating.
- The estimate is \$100,350.00.
- The end goal in the future will be to TV inspect the entire system and have all manholes located and have an access plan in place.
- Meisner asks how safe and maintenance proof this is for the town?
 - Bahr responds: "Flow improves, and works well for over 30 years. Roots cannot come in. One solid tube without any seams in the way. 50 year design life."
- Wickline recommends that "We should use this money wisely. It will go fast."
- The money is available. We just need to spend it correctly and break it up correctly in to separate projects to avoid delays.
- Walker has asked for a reference check from Green Mountain Pipeline.

Plant Operator Report- Some capital projects involving electrical work and a digital flow meter. and creating a better office. DEP does not like the office in the lab area.

- DEP report update. Since Chelsey is away on leave, an approved extension has been filed with DEP.

- Proper coverage has been attained and Evertett is assuming acting chief operator
- **Topics not anticipated-** Budget needs to be done soon. Everett will be in contact with Chelsey.
