- Julia Blyth, open space and recreation committee. A section on their sewer system policy has not been updated since the 90's
- Walker says the Dickinson Library, North towards the Elementary school has been partially done. Route 10 and 63 has not been upgraded.
- Chelsey says the average is around 100,000 gallons per day. This is a monthly average
- Little says there is still in-flow and infiltration issues and there is still a lot of I/I work to be done.
- Approximately 281 connections are on the lines. A slight variance. This is because some addresses have multiple hook ups.

Chief Operators Report-


- Chesley met with our town treasurer and town assessor so that the account numbers and multiple hook-up addresses can be updated... This will help lower the sewer rate!
