

Sewer Commission Meeting

**Call to order-** Meeting called to order at 3:40 PM

**Review of minutes-** A digital review of the March 31st minutes were motioned by Meisner and approved by the sewer commission

**Abatement discussion-** The board discussed the abatement of the St. Thomas Aquinas properties. A reply was sent via email that the bill is correct and that a representative of the college should meet with us to abate after the billing is paid.

**Isaac Golding job discussion-**

- Curious about vacation time and start date
- Golding wants 3 weeks vacation to start
  - Gray does not believe in having 3 weeks of vacation
  - Walker wants to offer 1 week at the start and then do a vacation and financial review at 6 months
  - Andrea believes that it starts with 2 weeks and you start accruing it at 6 months.
  - Deliberation has begun on salary Grade 11 Step 2. All are in agreement with this. Motion will be later...
  - Start date has been discussed that Golding would start
  - For the physical, we would hire him contingent on the ability to pass a physical. Hire him to work hourly and pick a start date in 3 weeks. Permanent employment will exist contingent on passing the physical. This way we have a start date.
  - May 4th, 2020 for an official start date
  - We will arrange for him to work at an hourly rate prior to this. \$28.21 per hour.
  - Commissioner Gray asks a question on plant improvement. Golding responds with no idea until he is there to brainstorm and come up with some ideas.

**Motion** by Meisner to hire Isaac Golding at Grade 11 Step 2 at an hourly rate of \$28.21 with an official start date of May 4th, 2020 contingent of licenses and medical check/ examination.

**Seconded** by Walker. **Passes** unanimously.

- Llamas and Golding exit the meeting.
- We are discussing as commissioners on how to be more diligent and to be more of a presence as a board.

**Topics not anticipated-**

- Walker brings forth an issue regarding beavers and buildups between glenwood and pine st which is affecting the manholes and a landowner's property. A trapper was going to come in if we are all on board with it. **Motion** by Tom Walker to move forward with the trapping of the beavers. **Seconded** by Gray. **Passes** unanimously as a commission
- We need to start spending money on piping that we have budgeted for. \$100,000 has been budgeted. Walker will follow up with the necessary bidding and processes.
