1. Minutes of June 6, 2017 were approved.

2. Member comments:

Jerry outlined work on the Ames accessible trail. Last Friday he met with Jay Rasku and Fletcher Harrington from MGLCT along with Dick O'Brien, an accessible trail consultant. Dick felt that the stone dust was too fine. Stone dust up to 3/8" which includes both fine and particulates works well because rain will tamp down the fine dust leaving a firm surface. Since the trail is too close to the pond, at the desired location, to accommodate the viewing platform separate from the trail, Jay and Fletcher will probably design the trail as part of the platform. The grant expires in December.

Joanne asked if anyone had heard about illegal trucks and padlock damage at Jere Nelson's property. Someone marked trees for logging.

Jerry has been emailing Amanda Lewis about the work at the DCR NMH ridge project. Amanda has asked Jerry to build the kiosks. Crews worked this summer but we are unsure if the trails are completed. The committee felt that we needed a public announcement.

3. Ch. 61 conservation priorities:

The committee discussed the latest draft. *Joanne will check on the accuracy of a parcel along the NET.* The committee voted to submit the latest draft version to the town administrator.
