- I will demand a sports environment that is free of drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use, within the immediate playing area, at all sports events.
- I understand that I will have equipment owned by the Northfield Recreation Commission checked out to me, that I will be responsible for said equipment and that I will return said equipment at the end of the season.
- I understand that failing to comply with any of the above could result in disciplinary action from the Northfield Recreation Commission, including suspension and/or removal of coaching privileges.
