

Substitute Senior Van Driver

The Bernardston Council on Aging is seeking a qualified candidate/s to work as a substitute senior van driver. The substitute Senior Van Driver will be responsible for providing rides for persons 60 years of age and older and for persons with disabilities in the towns of Bernardston and Northfield.

Driver must be able to safely operate a ten and/or a twelve passenger van, interact well with others, and be patient and dependable: Must be able to pass a CORI check, a physical examination, and a drug screening test, must have a valid driver's license and a clean driving record, and must be able to meet all training requirements for the position. Substitute van drivers are also required to learn data reporting requirements. This is an unbenefited regular part time position.

High School Graduate preferred with at least 3 years of driving experience. Customer service skills a plus.
