- Cameron's Winery. The Board has issued conditional approval for food service permit. Business will be inspected by Phil Ledger, on behalf of Town Health Agents who are currently out of state. Mr. Ledger will contact Board Chair directly with results of inspection once completed on 2/24/2017.
- The Board received a call from a parent of a student that attended a wrestling tournament at PVRS. Two participants came down very ill after returning home. Board Chair gathered all information from caller and followed up with the School Superintendent. No other participants or spectators of the event became ill. After speaking with the reporting party again, it was determined the students became ill after eating out on the drive back from the event. After further discussion, it was determined the Board would seek more detailed regulations from the Town Health Inspectors/Agents about bake sales/ pot luck at community events.
