Interim Selectboard Meetings

All Selectboard members attended the 10/13/16 Schell Bridge update w/ Senator Rosenberg, Mass DOT, and WPS engineers. Their assessment puts the cost of rehabilitating the bridge at about \$38 million, and of removing and rebuilding at around \$16 million. There is funding available for up to \$18 million, and the project is on a list to go out to bid and start construction in 2021—after more in depth design phase work.

- Thanks to Tom and the rest of the Highway Department for paving work in the Town Hall parking lot around the pellet silo, and for fixing the handicap ramp.
- The pellet stove is not yet running; it needs an electrical inspection.
