NORTHFIELD CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING MAY 18, 2022 MINUTES

Bill opened the meeting at 7:05 pm.

Samantha Harding is a property owner's representative regarding a parcel of land on Mt. Hermon Station Road, no address but adjacent to #644. She was inquiring about the **process for filing a NOI.** The property is wedge shaped with minimal frontage and needs a driveway that will cross a stream. Charlie recommended that Samantha speak with Jim Hawkins, Building Inspector, about a required width for the driveway, and field engineers will draw up plans for a culvert that needs to meet DEP guidelines. Samantha will get all abutters' addresses from Assessor's Office and, when the NOI is filed with DEP, a hearing will be held. Registered letters are to be sent (or hand delivered) to all abutters prior to a hearing, and ConCom members will do a site visit prior to hearing.

Bob Mizula shared that the emergency repair work at Nourse Farms has been completed. Bill agreed to file all paperwork with DEP. Bob is concerned about a second weakened site along the embankment.

Robin, on behalf of Northfield ConCom, drafted a letter to Carter Wall, FirstLight Gov't Affairs & Community Relations Mgr, requesting that FirstLight rectify the out-of-control bittersweet on their wetlands property between Rte 10 and Old Bernardston Road. Motion made (Charlie/Robin) and carried to approve letter as written, to sign by quorum of members, and then mailed.

Charlie reported that he has stopped by Andrew Vernon's home 4 times and has yet to speak with him regarding Andrew's letter of complaint.

Tori is interested in becoming a ConCom member. Bill explained the process for doing so. Another Forest Cutting Plan was in the mail.

April 21 minutes were approved as written. Meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.
