# **Simplified Filing** for **Intervenor Status** Workshop

As an intervenor, you gain the right to participate in a hearing, file a brief, and challenge a FERC decision (you don't have these rights if you simply file comments).

Intervening does not require you to hire a lawyer or participate further, it simply keeps the options open for you.

Participating as an intervenor does not require a physical presence at FERC. Correspondence on these matters is done in writing on the FERC website or by email.

Individuals, impacted landowners, organizations, businesses, municipalities and other entities can intervene.

- The <u>regulatory requirements</u> specify what you should include in your motion.
- Provide sufficient detail to show that you have or represent an "interest which may be directly affected by the outcome of the proceeding".
- Also state that you are opposed to the project (or whatever position you are taking, "to the extent known").
- State that you have interests that cannot adequately be represented by another party, bring a unique perspective, etc.

### WHO: who can be an intervenor?

Any individual or group/organization who feels they are impacted by the pipeline project can be an intervenor.

### WHY: why be an intervenor?

Anyone who wants to participate (to make their voice heard) and/or have legal standing in the FERC process would want to be an intervenor.

### HOW: how to become an intervenor?

Any individual or group/organization that wants to become an intervenor can file a Motion to Intervene with FERC.

### WHERE: where do I file a Motion to Intervene?

A Motion to Intervene is filed with FERC either online at <u>http://ferc.gov</u> (much preferred) or via postal mail.

### WHEN: when do I file?

The deadline to file for intervenor status is: 5pm January 6, 2016!

### List of possible reasons for stakeholder status

- Directly impacted landowner

- Abutter/resident whose health, safety, property value, drinking water, home,

may be affected

- Ratepayer (Gas or Electric)
  - Utilities will seek to charge ratepayers for the cost of capacity contracted for on NED.
  - Consumers may also suffer increased cost of gas due to exporting to foreign markets.

Gas utilities (including Berkshire Gas, Columbia Gas, Liberty Utilities and National Grid's gas company) have contracted for capacity on NED; according to KM's plan, electric utilities may also purchase capacity on NED.

### List of possible reasons for stakeholder status (cont.)

- Proximity to any infrastructure within the blast radius ("potential impact radius")
- Proximity to compressor station and/or blow down valve Toxic emissions
- Proximity to pigging station Groundwater contamination
- Impacted by socio-economic consequences (businesses, organic farms, utility rates, etc)
- Donor to land trust concerned about public trust violation
- Visitor to/user of protected land or impacted rivers and streams

### How to File a Motion to Intervene

There are two electronic (preferred) methods to filing:

Doc-less : just type in your reasons up to 6,000 characters
 E-Filing : upload a prepared document of unlimited size

You can also file via postal mail if you are unable to file electronically. Must send an original and three (3) copies of the motion to intervene by overnight services to:

#### **Document-less Intervention Description**

Ch

I am a landowner in <u>Cummington</u>, Massachusetts. I invested everything I have into moving to this community in 2002 for many reasons, including accessibility to dark night skies and to assure that I can grow my own organic vegetables and free-range chickens in a clean environment, away from industrial development. In doing so, it was and remains my intent to live the remainder of my life in this community.

Construction of the NED pipeline would mean that I would now be situated:

- 3 miles downwind of the proposed 41,000 horsepower compressor station in Windsor. This would place my property within the drift zone particulate matter and other toxic pollutants and light pollution in what is now "the darkest corner of New England". This is the reason an astronomy center exists 1.5 miles from my home and why the Notchview reservation (abutting the compressor station site property) holds astronomy and "stargazing" events among its many other nature-oriented programs, and was the primary factor in my choosing to live here. The effects of living downwind of the compressor would include not only damage to my ability to grow my own food in a clean environment, but risks to the health of me, my family and community from breathing pollutants and particulate matter.
