All organics: food waste includingbones, cheese, clementine boxes (remove plastic), waxed cardboard & cat litter.


Please-no plastics, grass clippings, brush cuttings

Other Collections

- Pizza boxes & paper go in compactors labeled #1 & #4
- Styrofoam packing peanuts and cooler boxes are being collected.
 Please have packing peanuts in plastic bags.
- Cardboard and clear plastic egg cartons (dozen size) are being collected to distribute to egg sellers.
- Batteries: separate rechargeable and button batteries from alkaline. Lead acid (vehicle) batteries also collected.
- Wood pellet bags are collected and returned to be recycled.
- All textiles deposited in the Salvation Army box.
- Worn U. S. Flags deposited in the V.F.W. Collection box
